FOUNDATIONAL TEXT

John 1:16-17 AMP - For out of His fullness (abundance) we have **all received** [all had a share and we were all supplied with] one grace after another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favour upon favour and gift [heaped] upon gift. For while the Law was given through Moses, grace (unearned, undeserved favour and spiritual blessing) and truth came through Jesus Christ.

1. Revelation – What does the Book of Ephesians tell us?

- The theme of Ephesians is living in community with God and with one another
- It's a book for revival. Paul wrote it to keep the church in revival in Ephesus
- It's all about the Godhead, as we understand who God is and what He's done, it changes our identity
- The letter shows the balance in the Christian life between Doctrine Chapters 1-3 [Divine Sovereignty] & Duty- Chapters 4-6 [Human Responsibility]
- We do not obey God so that He will give us His grace, we obey Him in response to the grace he has already given us
- We are all called to fight the good fight of faith and to take our stand against the spiritual forces of darkness
- 'In Christ' occurs 27 times in this book over 150 times in Paul's writings
- *Grace* is not just a doctrine Grace is a person *Jesus*
- *Truth* is not just information Truth is a person *Jesus*

2. Interpretation – The word of God

For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

*Paul planted many churches, but the bible gives credit to Paul for being a prayer warrior more than planting churches [I believe]. Often times he says "I'm praying for you without ceasing' I keep asking, I pray in the spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and the team with me, they're not just professional Christian's, they pray with me. I have this guy, Epaphras who is one like you, who is always wrestling in prayer for you. That's who Paul has on his team - prayer warriors.

The warrior of the Lord We worship, then walk and then we are ready to stand to war – that is the Progression of Paul's writings in the Book of Ephesians.

We walk it out and then we fight. Some of us want to fight but we haven't got a clue how to worship or how to walk out our salvation, so we're living in sin, we're living in unbelief, but we want to fight. It will never work. Why? Because of out of who God is, we worship [God I'm here for you, you are sovereign, you're divine, salvation is yours] then I'll walk out my life [worthy of the Lord]. Am I perfect? No, but I do what he tells me to do and out of that place I can take my stand, and having done all to stand, I stand in VICTORY.

He is the Peacemaker – reconciles man to God and man to man as well 2:11-18	Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands—that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity. And He came and preached peace to you who were afar off and to those who were near. For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.	
He is the chief Cornerstone of the new temple 2:19-22	Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.	
He is the Treasure of unsearchable riches 3:8	To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,

The Spirit is our down payment , guaranteeing our complete redemption - 1:14	Who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.
The Spirit is the Revealer who enlightening our hearts to perceive God's purpose - 1:17-18	That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.
